*Discuss:* famous London sights.
- 33 Rent a bike to travel around the country. What would you like to see? Move to 48.  
*Discuss:* bike – pros and cons, Britain's places of interest

*Discuss:* British music scene
- 41 Miss a turn to post to your travel blog.  
*Discuss:* What would/ wouldn't you write about?
- 44 Fly to Dublin and move to 49.  
*Discuss:* Dublin; planes – pros and cons
- 52 Hitchhike around Ireland and move to 60.  
*Discuss:* Ireland; hitchhiking – pros and cons
- 61 Fly to New York and go to 68.  
*Discuss:* New York and its sights
- 69 Travel around the USA and move to 73.  
*Discuss:* Prepare an itinerary.  
*Writing:* Write a postcard from your holiday.

*Discuss:* What summer jobs do students do?
