Teacher's Notes

You're going on a trip around the world.

You'll need: Hello! Travelling Board Game, a die, colourful markers for each student

How to play:

Take turns and roll the die. Place the markers on the correct number. The aim is to get back home as soon as possible.

 - Discuss: cars pros and cons
- You've promised to call your mother regularly. Call home to say you're OK and miss a turn.

 Discuss: What other ways of communication can you use while travelling? Which do you prefer?
- 16 Take a train to Dover and move to number 25.
 - Discuss: trains pros and cons
- 22 You want to get to London. Decide if you'll take a ferry or will go by the Chunnel. Go to 28.
 - Discuss: Compare the two possibilities of crossing the English Cannel.
- 26 You're in London. Spend a day sightseeing and miss a turn.
 - Discuss: famous London sights.
- Rent a bike to travel around the country. What would you like to see? Move to 48.
 - Discuss: bike pros and cons, Britain's places of interest
- 39 Get back to England to a summer music festival. Go back to 36.
 - Discuss: British music scene
- 41 Miss a turn to post to your travel blog.
 - Discuss: What would/wouldn't you write about?
- 44 Fly to Dublin and move to 49.
 - Discuss: Dublin; planes pros and cons
- 52 Hitchhike around Ireland and move to 60.
 - Discuss: Ireland; hitchiking pros and cons
- 61 Fly to New York and go to 68.
 - Discuss: New York and its sights
- 69 Travel around the USA and move to 73.
 - Discuss: Prepare an itinerary.
 - Writing: Write a postcard from your holiday.
